I. Term Limits

A. Maximum duration in office

1. Branch exchequers will serve no more than four consecutive years in office.
2. After serving four years, a branch exchequer will take a respite of one full year at minimum before taking another branch level exchequer officer position.

B. Duration of terms

1. First term in office is two years.
2. Subsequent terms in office are one year each.
3. Branches may define their own terms, so long as they do not exceed these definitions.

C. Application of policy to existing officers

1. Term limits for branch exchequers have not previously existed, and branch exchequers might already be serving beyond the four year limit.
2. Branch exchequers that are currently in office and are already beyond the four year limit may finish their current term.
3. Under no circumstances may a branch exchequer who is already beyond the four year limit continue in their current term beyond June 1, 2023.
